Deep ruby. Blackberry, cherry liqueur, garrigue and candied lavender on the deeply perfumed nose. Focused red and blue fruit flavors coat the palate, showing excellent clarity and bright mineral lift. The cherry and floral qualities come back strong on the impressively persistent finish, which is given shape and gentle grip by smooth, harmonious tannins.

Brilliant ruby. Ripe cherry, dark berries and cherry liqueur on the spice—accented nose and in the mouth. Sappy, sweet and expansive, offering intense blackberry and licorice flavors that tighten up slowly with air. Fleshy, seamless and nicely focused, displaying harmonious tannins, strong back-end thrust and lingering sweetness.

Light yellow. Dried pear, pungent flowers and herbs on the nose, along with a hint of beeswax in the background. Fleshy and dry, showing good depth and breadth to the orchard and pit fruit flavors. A bitter lemon pith note firms the finish, which features warm, clinging pear nectar and fennel qualities.

Appealingly sweet and seamless in texture, showing very good focus and cut to the intense black raspberry and cherry flavors. Finishes with slow-building tannins, delivering impressive clarity and strong, floral-driven persistence..
